- (5)] A licensed assistant teacher may teach cosmetology only under the supervision of a licensed teacher.
- (c) :While a SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST license [to manage a beauty salon] is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to:
- (1) [manage] SUPERVISE a beauty salon that holds a beauty salon permit;
- (2) practice cosmetology.
- (a) [Except as provided in § 5-318 of this subtitle, unless] UNLESS a license is renewed for a 2 year term as provided in this section, the license expires on the first October 31 that comes:
  - (1) after the effective date of the license; and
  - (2) in an odd numbered year.
- (b) At least 1 month before a license expires, the Board shall mail to the licensee, at the last known address of the licensee:
  - (1) a renewal application form; and
  - (2) a notice that states:

and

- (i) the date on which the current-license-expires;
- (ii) the date by which the Board must receive the renewal application for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
  - (iii) the amount of the renewal fee.
- (c) Before a license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2 year term, if the licensee:
  - (1) otherwise is entitled to be licensed;
  - (2) pays to the Board a renewal fee of:
    - (i) \$25 for a license to practice cosmetology;
    - (ii) \$25 for a limited license;
    - (HI) \$50 FOR AN ASSISTANT TEACHER LICENSE;
    - {(iii)}(IV) \$50 for a license to teach cosmetology; or
  - {(iv)}(V) \$50 for a license to [manage] SUPERVISE a beauty salon;
- (3) submits to the Board a renewal application on the form that the Board provides.
