- (2) submits to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and
  - (3) pays to the Board an application fee of \$1.
- (c) While a temporary license is in effect, it authorizes the holder to practice cosmetology.
- (d) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, a temporary license expires 1 month after the date of the examination next scheduled after its issuance.
- (2) If the holder of a temporary license does not take a scheduled examination, the license expires on the date of the scheduled examination.]

## [5 319.] 5 317.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each license issued under this subtitle shall be displayed conspicuously by the licensee in the office or place of employment of the licensee.
- (b) During hours of employment, the holder of a limited license to provide [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services:
  - (1) shall carry the limited license; and
  - (2) on request, shall show the limited license.

## f5 320.1 5 318.

- (a) Subject to the hearing provisions of [§-5-321] § 5-319 of this subtitle, the Board may deny a license to any applicant, reprimand any licensee, or suspend or revoke a license if the applicant or licensee:
- (1) fraudulently or deceptively obtains or attempts to obtain a license for the applicant or licensee or for another;
  - (2) fraudulently or deceptively uses a license;
  - (3) is [grossly] incompetent;
  - (4) engages in dishonest, unethical, immoral, or unprofessional conduct;
- (5) is addicted to alcohol or drugs to the extent of being unfit to practice cosmetology;
  - (6) advertises by means of knowingly false or deceptive statements; or
- (7) violates any provision of this title or any regulation adopted by the Board under this title.
- (b) Instead of or in addition to suspending or revoking a license, the Board may impose a penalty not exceeding \$500 FOR ALL VIOLATIONS CITED ON A SINGLE DATE.
