~~(b) A beauty salon may operate as a limited practice beauty salon by offering cosmetology services limited to:~~

- ~~(1) providing [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services;~~
- ~~(2) providing esthetic services; OR~~
- ~~(3) providing manicuring services[; or~~
- ~~(4) providing wig-styling services].~~

~~(c) A separate beauty salon permit is required for each beauty salon that a person operates.~~

~~(a) To qualify for a beauty salon permit, an applicant shall meet the requirements of this section.~~

~~(b) An applicant shall own or lease the beauty salon for which the application is made.~~

~~(c) [An applicant for an owner manager permit shall:~~

- ~~(1) be licensed to manage a beauty salon; and~~
- ~~(2) manage the beauty salon for which the application is made.~~

~~[(d)] As a condition of the issuance of a beauty salon permit, the beauty salon for which the application is made shall pass the inspection[, if any,] conducted under [§ 5-521] § 5-520 of this subtitle.~~
