~~(a) Except as otherwise provided in this section, whenever a beauty salon is in operation, it shall be under the direct supervision of an individual who is licensed [to manage a beauty salon] AS A SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST.~~

~~(b) A beauty salon permit holder [promptly] shall [submit to the Board written notice of each change of managers of the beauty salon] DESIGNATE 1 OR MORE SENIOR COSMETOLOGISTS TO SUPERVISE AND ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE SALON.~~

~~(c) A limited practice beauty salon authorized under § 5-501(b) of this subtitle:~~

~~(1) is not required to be operated under the direct supervision of a licensed [manager] SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST; but~~

~~(a) An applicant for a beauty salon permit shall:~~

~~(1) submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; [and]~~

~~(2) pay to the Board an application fee of \$50; AND~~

~~(3) PAY TO THE BOARD AN INSPECTION FEE OF \$25.~~

~~(b) In addition to any other information required on the application form, the form shall require the applicant:~~

~~(1) to indicate if the application is for a limited practice beauty salon [or owner manager permit]; and~~

~~(2) if the presence of a [licensed manager] SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST is required under § 5-503 of this subtitle, to state the name of the [manager] SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST of the beauty salon.~~
