The Board may reinstate the beauty salon permit or school permit of a person whose beauty salon permit or school permit has been suspended or revoked under ~~§ 5-523] § 5-522~~ of this subtitle if the person:

(1) applies to the Board for reinstatement of the beauty salon permit or school permit; and

(2) provides to the Board adequate evidence that the applicant is qualified to have the beauty salon permit or school permit reinstated.

Except as otherwise provided in this title, a person may not [manage] SUPERVISE, attempt to [manage] SUPERVISE, or offer to [manage] SUPERVISE a beauty salon in the State unless licensed by the Board [to manage a beauty salon] AS A SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST.

(e) Unless authorized under this title to [manage] SUPERVISE a beauty salon, a person may not represent to the public, by use of a title, including "licensed [beauty salon manager] SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST", by description of services, methods, or procedures, or otherwise, that the person is authorized to [manage] SUPERVISE a beauty salon in the State.

(a) Except as provided in §§ 5-302 and 5-303 of this title and subsection (b) of this section, a person may not practice cosmetology in any place other than:

(1) a beauty salon that holds a beauty salon permit; or

(2) a barbershop that holds a barbershop permit issued under Title 4 of this article, if the practice is conducted under the supervision of an individual licensed [to manage a beauty salon] AS A SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST.

(b) (1) A licensed cosmetologist may practice cosmetology in the residence of a patron, IN A NURSING HOME, OR IN A HOSPITAL AS DEFINED IN § 19-301 OF THE HEALTH GENERAL ARTICLE OR A SIMILAR INSTITUTION, by appointment, iff:

(i) the licensed cosmetologist is sponsored by a beauty salon that holds a beauty salon permit; and

(ii) the patron is a customer of the beauty salon].
