 - [(ii)] 2. bleaching the hair;
 - [(iii)] 3. cleansing the hair;
 - [(iv)] 4. coloring the hair;
 - [(v)] 5. curling the hair;
 - [(vi)] 6. cutting the hair;
 - [(vii)] 7. dressing the hair;
 - [(viii)] 8. singeing the hair;
 - [(ix)] 9. permanent waving the hair;
 - [(x)] 10. waving the hair; or
- [(xi)] 11. performing any other similar procedure intended to beautify, clean, or embellish the hair;
 - [(2)] (II) for compensation, arching or dyeing eyebrows;
 - [(3)] (III) for compensation, dyeing eyelashes;
 - [(4)] (IV) providing [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services;
 - [(5)] (V) providing esthetic services; OR
 - [(6)] (VI) providing manicuring services[; or
 - (7) providing wig styling services].
