

(1) [\$50] A REASONABLE FEE SET BY THE BOARD for each day on which the member is engaged in the duties of office; and

(2) reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations.

(d) (E) (1) The Board may employ a staff in accordance with the State budget.

(2) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE BOARD SHALL BE A LICENSED SENIOR COSMETOLOGIST OR A MASTER BARBER.

(e) (F) The Board shall have its principal office in Baltimore City.

5-205.

(A) In addition to any duties set forth elsewhere, the Board shall adopt:

(1) bylaws for the conduct of its proceedings;

(2) regulations for qualification and examination of applicants for licenses, registration, and permits and issuance of licenses, certificates of registration, and permits;

(3) regulations to govern the conduct of persons regulated under this title;

(4) regulations to govern sanitation and safety in practicing cosmetology, including regulations that establish precautions to prevent the spread of infectious and contagious diseases;

[(5) regulations to govern the establishment and teaching of courses of instruction in a limited practice of cosmetology;] and

[(6)] (5) regulations to govern the direct supervision of the operation of limited practice beauty salons.

(B) (1) THE BOARD SHALL ESTABLISH REASONABLE FEES FOR LICENSING, LICENSING RENEWALS, REINSTATEMENTS, CERTIFICATIONS, APPLICATIONS, PREOPENING INSPECTIONS, PER DIEM FEES FOR BOARD MEMBERS, COMPENSATION FOR INSPECTORS APPOINTED BY THE BOARD, AND FOR ANY OTHER SERVICE PERFORMED BY THE BOARD NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

(2) THE FEES ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE SET IN A MANNER THAT WILL PRODUCE FUNDS SUFFICIENT TO COVER THE ACTUAL DIRECT AND INDIRECT COSTS OF REGULATING THE COSMETOLOGY INDUSTRY IN THE STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE.

(3) THE TOTAL COST OF REGULATING THE COSMETOLOGY INDUSTRY IN THE STATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF THIS TITLE MAY NOT BE MORE THAN THE REVENUES GENERATED BY THE FEES ESTABLISHED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION.
