(d) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, an applicant for a license to teach cosmetology shall pass the appropriate examination given by the Board under this subtitle.]

(a) To qualify for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services, manicuring services, or wig styling services, the applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.

(b) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services shall:

- (1) be at least 18 years old;
- (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
- (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
- (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide esthetic services.

(c) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing manicuring services shall:

- (1) be at least 18 years old;
- (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
- (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
- (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide manicuring services.

(d) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing wig styling services shall:

- (1) be at least 18 years old;
- (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
- (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
- (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide wig styling services.

(e) An applicant for a license to teach a limited practice of cosmetology shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.]

(a) To qualify for a license to manage a beauty salon, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.

(b) An applicant shall be at least 18 years old.
