- (iii) have completed successfully a degree program in cosmetology education at the University of Maryland or a similar institution approved by the Board.
- (d) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, an applicant for a license to teach cosmetology shall pass the appropriate examination given by the Board under this subtitle.]

[5-308.

- (a) To qualify for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services, manicuring services, or wig styling services, the applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
- (b) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing esthetic services shall:
 - (1) be at least 18 years old;
 - (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
 - (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
 - (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide esthetic services.
- (c) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing manicuring services shall:
 - (1) be at least 18 years old;
 - (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
 - (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
 - (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide manicuring services.
- (d) An applicant for a license to teach cosmetology limited to providing wig styling services shall:
 - (1) be at least 18 years old;
 - (2) be a high school graduate or the equivalent;
 - (3) meet the training requirements that the Board sets, by regulation; and
 - (4) have been licensed for at least 2 years to provide wig styling services.
- (e) An applicant for a license to teach a limited practice of cosmetology shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.]

<u>[5-309.</u>

- (a) To qualify for a license to manage a beauty salon, an applicant shall be an individual who meets the requirements of this section.
 - (b) An applicant shall be at least 18 years old.
