

(c) An applicant shall:

(1) be a licensed cosmetologist; and

(2) have at least 2 years of experience as a licensed cosmetologist.

(d) An applicant shall pass an examination given by the Board under this subtitle.]

(a) An applicant for a license:

(1) shall submit to the Board an application on the form that the Board provides; and

(2) except as provided in [§ 5-312] § 5-308 of this subtitle, shall pay to the Board [an] THE APPROPRIATE application fee [of:

(i) \$10 for a license to practice cosmetology;

(ii) \$50 for a license to teach cosmetology or a limited practice of cosmetology; or

(iii) \$25 for any other license] ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-205 OF THIS TITLE.

(b) In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for a license to provide [demonstrating] MAKEUP ARTIST services shall submit to the Board credentials that certify sufficient training [in each category of cosmetology to be demonstrated].

[(c) In addition to the other requirements of this section, an applicant for a cosmetologist-aide license shall submit to the Board a certificate that is made under oath by an authorized physician and certifies that the applicant is free from any contagious or infectious disease that presents a hazard to a beauty salon patron.]

(a) An applicant who otherwise qualifies for a license is entitled to be examined as provided in this section.

(b) (1) The Board may employ examiners to give examinations to applicants and designate an examiner to give the written or practical parts of the examination or both.

(2) Subject to the State budget, each examiner is entitled to REASONABLE compensation [of at least \$30] SET BY THE BOARD for each day on which the examiner is engaged in the duties of the employment.

(c) The Board periodically shall give examinations to applicants at the times and places that the Board determines.

(d) The Board shall give each qualified applicant notice of the time and place of examination.
