

(e) (1) The Board shall determine the subjects, scope, and form of and the passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.

(2) An examination may consist of written and practical parts.

(f) The Board shall mail to each applicant notice of the applicant's examination result.

(a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to practice [cosmetology] AS A COSMETOLOGIST OR A LIMITED PRACTICE COSMETOLOGIST in another state.

(b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:

(1) pays to the Board an application fee [of \$25] ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-205 OF THIS TITLE; and

(2) provides adequate evidence that the applicant:

(i) meets the qualifications otherwise required by this subtitle; and

(ii) became licensed in the other state after meeting, in that or any other state, requirements that are at least equivalent to the licensing requirements of this State.

(a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board may waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to teach cosmetology in another state.

(b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:

(1) pays to the Board the application fee required under § 5-310 of this subtitle; and

(2) provides to the Board adequate evidence that the applicant:

(i) meets the qualifications otherwise required under this subtitle; and

(ii) became licensed in the other state after passing, in that or any other state, an examination that is similar to the examination for which the applicant is seeking the waiver.]

[(a) Except for an applicant for a cosmetologist-aide license, if] IF an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:

(1) the applicant has qualified for the license; and
