- (e) (1) The Board shall determine the subjects, scope, and form of and the passing score for examinations given under this subtitle.
  - (2) An examination may consist of written and practical parts.
- (f) The Board shall mail to each applicant notice of the applicant's examination result.

## [5-312.] 5-308.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board shall waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to practice [cosmetology] AS A COSMETOLOGIST OR A LIMITED PRACTICE COSMETOLOGIST in another state.
  - (b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:
- (1) pays to the Board an application fee [of \$25] ESTABLISHED BY THE BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 5-205 OF THIS TITLE; and
  - (2) provides adequate evidence that the applicant:
    - (i) meets the qualifications otherwise required by this subtitle; and
- (ii) became licensed in the other state after meeting, in that or any other state, requirements that are at least equivalent to the licensing requirements of this State.

## [5-313.

- (a) Subject to the provisions of this section, the Board may waive any examination requirement of this subtitle for an individual who is licensed to teach cosmetology in another state.
  - (b) The Board may grant a waiver under this section only if the applicant:
- (1) pays to the Board the application fee required under § 5-310 of this subtitle; and
  - (2) provides to the Board adequate evidence that the applicant:
    - (i) meets the qualifications otherwise required under this subtitle; and
- (ii) became licensed in the other state after passing, in that or any other state, an examination that is similar to the examination for which the applicant is seeking the waiver.]

## [5-314.] 5-309.

- [(a) Except for an applicant for a cosmetologist-aide license, if] IF an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:
  - (1) the applicant has qualified for the license; and
