

(2) ALLOW A MINOR TO BE EMPLOYED IN VIOLATION OF A PROVISION OF THIS SUBTITLE.

(C) PENALTIES.

(1) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 90 DAYS OR BOTH.

(2) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES ANY PROVISION OF SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.

In subsection (a)(1) of this section, the reference to interfering with or hindering "the performance of any duty of the Commissioner" is substituted for the former reference to interfering with or hindering "the Commissioner in the performance of his duties", to preserve the scope of former Art. 100, § 14(a) when read together with former Art. 100, § 4(e). Former § 4(e) defined "Commissioner" to include "his authorized representative" and now is revised in § 3-104 of this title as authority for subdelegation of responsibility.

3-301. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

(B) EMPLOYER.

(1) "EMPLOYER" MEANS:

(I) A PERSON ENGAGED IN A BUSINESS, INDUSTRY, PROFESSION, TRADE, OR OTHER ENTERPRISE IN THE STATE;

(II) THE STATE AND ITS UNITS;

(III) A COUNTY AND ITS UNITS; AND
