FOR the purpose of ~~altering~~ requiring certain rules and regulations of the mandatory minority business program of the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission; ~~requiring certain rules and regulations to include provisions that establish a sheltered market component;~~ provide for minority participation through subcontracting, permit the waiver of all or any part of the program under certain conditions, and provide for graduation from the program under certain conditions; clarifying the types of certification that may be recognized under the program; ~~altering the definition of minority business enterprise;~~ altering certain dates for certain reports; delaying the date on which the program becomes null and void; making provisions of this Act severable; making technical changes; and generally relating to the mandatory minority business program of the WSSC.
