CHAPTER 554

(House Bill 374)

AN ACT concerning

Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission – Planning Boards – Personnel

MC/PG 25-91

FOR the purpose of excluding certain directors ~~or deputy directors~~ of the Commission from a certain merit system with certain exceptions; ~~authorizing the County Executive for Prince George's County to appoint certain directors or deputy directors subject to confirmation by the Prince George's County Council;~~ establishing certain qualifications for certain directors ~~or deputy directors~~; providing for the compensation for certain directors ~~or deputy directors~~; specifying that certain directors ~~or deputy directors~~ serve at the pleasure of the ~~County Executive for~~ Prince George's County Planning Board with certain exceptions; and generally relating to personnel of the Prince George's County planning board and the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article 28 – Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission

2-112.

(a) The Commission shall put into effect a merit system adopted pursuant to this section. In it shall be included all employees of the Commission, except:

- (1) The commissioners;
- (2) All appointed officials as provided in § 2-106 of this title; and
- (3) In Prince George's County[, the]:

(I) THE deputy chief of park police as provided in § 5-114(b) of this article; AND
