

indirectly, from funds of the State, whether appropriated or unappropriated. ~~The~~ No part of the fund may consist of real property, in kind ~~contributions~~ contributions, or funds expended prior to the effective date of this Act. The matching fund of the Worcester Memorial Hospital Corporation may consist of funds received from a municipal corporation. In case of any dispute as to the amount of the matching fund or what money or assets may qualify as matching funds, the Board of Public Works shall determine the matter, and the Board's decision is final. Worcester Memorial Hospital Corporation and the Board of County Commissioners of Worcester County have until June 1, 1993, to present evidence satisfactory to the Board of Public Works that a matching fund will be provided. If satisfactory evidence is presented, the Board shall certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 573

(House Bill 556)

AN ACT concerning

Dorchester County – Tax Credit – Warehouse Plant Facilities

FOR the purpose of authorizing Dorchester County to grant a property tax credit against the county property tax imposed on certain real property of certain commercial warehouse plant facilities; and limiting the tax credit for a certain number of years.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Tax – Property

9-311.

(a) The governing body of Dorchester County and of a municipal corporation in Dorchester County shall grant a property tax credit under this section against the county and municipal corporation property tax imposed on:

(1) property that on July 1, 1969 was owned by the Women's Auxiliary of the Dorchester Memorial Hospital; and
