

(6) (a) The St. Mary's County Historical Society shall grant and convey to the Maryland Historical Trust a perpetual preservation easement on Tudor Hall to the extent of its interest:

(i) On the land or such portion of the land acceptable to the Trust;
and

(ii) On the exterior and interior, where appropriate, of the historic structures.

(b) The easement must be in form and substance acceptable to the Trust and the extent of the interest to be encumbered must be acceptable to the Trust.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 575

(House Bill 561)

AN ACT concerning

**Workers' Compensation – Volunteer Fire Fighters, Rescue Squad Members, and
Advanced Life Support Personnel – Coverage**

FOR the purpose of providing that volunteer fire fighters, rescue squad members, and advanced life support personnel who are covered by the workers' compensation law are covered while accompanying certain victims being transported by helicopter and while returning to their home station; including volunteer advanced life support units in certain definitions to provide workers' compensation coverage to members of volunteer advanced life support units under certain circumstances; deleting certain references to advanced life support units made superfluous by this Act; and generally relating to the coverage of volunteer fire fighters, rescue squad members, and advanced life support personnel.
