

(w) (1) Unless an election is made under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a member of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in Washington County is not a covered employee.

(2) The Board of County Commissioners for Washington County may provide by resolution for members of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in the county to be covered employees while on duty.

(x) (1) A member of a volunteer company in Wicomico County is a covered employee.

(2) The County Council of Wicomico County may provide by resolution for members of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in the county to be a covered employee while on duty.

(y) (1) Unless an election is made under paragraph (2) of this subsection, a member of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in Worcester County is not a covered employee.

(2) The Board of County Commissioners for Worcester County may provide by resolution for members of a volunteer company [or an advanced life support unit] in the county to be covered employees while on duty.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 576

(House Bill 603)

AN ACT concerning

Civil Actions – Setback Line Restrictions – Limitations

FOR the purpose of clarifying that a person may not initiate an action or proceeding that arises out of the failure of a building or structure to comply with a setback line restriction after a certain time period under certain circumstances; providing that a person may not initiate an action or proceeding that arises out of a failure of a building or structure to comply with a setback line restriction after a certain time period under certain circumstances; providing that a building permit issued under certain circumstances shall be considered a valid permit, notwithstanding other laws to the contrary, for purposes of this Act; defining a certain term; providing for the application of this Act; making provisions of this Act severable; and generally relating to periods of limitations for actions or proceedings for failure to comply with a setback line restriction.
