SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – Courts and Judicial Proceedings

5-114.

(a) (1) In this section, the following words have the meanings indicated.

(2) “BUILDING PERMIT” OR “PERMIT” INCLUDES A SITE PLAN AND OTHER DOCUMENTATION SUBMITTED IN SUPPORT OF AN APPLICATION FOR A BUILDING PERMIT AND PROVIDING THE BASIS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF THE BUILDING PERMIT.

[(2)] (3) “Highway” means any way or thoroughfare, whether or not the way or thoroughfare has been dedicated to the public or a dedication has been accepted.

[(3)] (4) “Local government” means:

- (i) A chartered county established under Article 25A of the Code;
- (ii) A code county established under Article 25B of the Code;
- (iii) A board of county commissioners established or operating under Article 25 of the Code;
- (iv) Baltimore City;
- (v) A municipal corporation established or operating under Article 23A of the Code;
- (vi) A special taxing district; or
- (vii) Any other political subdivision.

[(4)] (5) “Person” includes:

- (i) An individual;
- (ii) The State; and
- (iii) A local government, including an officer, department, agency, board, commission, or other unit of a local government.

[(5)] (6) “Property line” means the line marking the boundary between 2 separate lots or parcels of property.
