

(3) (i) A license issued under this section may authorize the operation of [more]:

1. MORE than 1 raffle at the same time; OR
2. A RAFFLE ON SUNDAY.

(ii) For purposes of this section, a raffle is deemed to be operated on the day the raffle winners are selected.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 578

(House Bill 622)

AN ACT concerning

Handicapped Students – Suspension or Expulsion

FOR the purpose of altering certain periods for which certain handicapped students may be removed from a current educational placement; authorizing certain committees to extend certain handicapped students' periods of removal under certain circumstances; providing that this Act does not preempt any ordinance, resolution, law, or rule more stringent than this Act; and generally relating to suspension and expulsion of handicapped students.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

7-304.

(e) (1) A handicapped student may not be removed from the student's current educational placement for more than 10 school days each [semester] SCHOOL YEAR unless:
