

certify this fact and the amount of the matching fund to the State Treasurer, and the proceeds of the loan equal to the amount of the matching fund shall be expended for the purposes provided in this Act. Any amount of the loan in excess of the amount of the matching fund certified by the Board of Public Works shall be canceled and be of no further effect.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 590

(House Bill 776)

AN ACT concerning

Historic St. Mary's City Commission

FOR the purpose of terminating the existence of the St. Mary's City Commission; creating a new commission to be called the Historic St. Mary's City Commission; providing for the purpose, membership, terms, appointments, powers, duties, officers, voting, and meetings of the new Commission; providing for an executive director and staff for the Commission; providing for a budget and for the duties of the executive director; providing that certain provisions of law formerly applying to the St. Mary's City Commission shall now apply, with changes, to the Historic St. Mary's City Commission; providing that certain staff are transferred to the new Commission without the loss of certain rights; clarifying that terms of members of the St. Mary's City Commission terminate with that Commission; specifying the terms of initial Commission members; providing that the Governor shall name the initial chairman for a certain term; providing that certain rights, powers, duties, funds, regulations, and other legally binding actions of the St. Mary's City Commission are transferred to the Historic St. Mary's City Commission; requiring certain joint plans and reports from the new Commission and the St. Mary's College of Maryland Board of Trustees to the Governor; altering the membership of the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland to add the chairman of the Commission; altering the duties of that Board; and generally relating to the termination of the St. Mary's City Commission and the creation of the Historic St. Mary's City Commission.
