

(1) 12 SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE AS FOLLOWS:

(I) 3 SHALL BE SCHOLARS OF NATIONAL STATURE, 1 OF WHOM IS AN ARCHAEOLOGIST AND 1 OF WHOM IS A COLONIAL HISTORIAN;

(II) 1 SHALL BE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM A NATIONALLY PROMINENT MUSEUM;

(III) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF THE MARYLAND BUSINESS COMMUNITY;

(IV) 6 SHALL BE MEMBERS OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AT LEAST 1 OF WHOM IS A PROMINENT MEMBER OF THE ST. MARY'S COUNTY COMMUNITY; AND

(V) 1 SHALL POSSESS KNOWLEDGE OR EXPERIENCE IN LAND PRESERVATION, LAND CONSERVATION, OR A CLOSELY RELATED FIELD; AND

(2) 1 SHALL BE THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ST. MARY'S COLLEGE OF MARYLAND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OR THE CHAIRMAN'S DESIGNEE.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF A MEMBER IS 4 YEARS AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES. THESE TERMS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS OF MEMBERS AS OF JULY 1, 1991.

(2) A MEMBER APPOINTED TO FILL A VACANCY IN AN UNEXPIRED TERM SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THAT TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.

(3) A MEMBER MAY BE APPOINTED TO NO MORE THAN 2 FULL CONSECUTIVE TERMS. A MEMBER WHO HAS SERVED LESS THAN A FULL 4-YEAR TERM MAY BE REAPPOINTED TO 2 FULL TERMS.

Each Commissioner [shall be paid \$25 per diem for each day or part of day spent on Commission business, and] shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred while actually engaged in the performance of [their] THE COMMISSIONER'S duties in accordance with the Standard STATE Travel Regulations.

(a) Subject to the provisions of § 5-206 of this subtitle, [the Commission has the powers and duties listed in this section] and IN ADDITION TO ANY POWERS PROVIDED elsewhere in this subtitle [or delegated to it by the Secretary.], THE COMMISSION HAS THE FOLLOWING POWERS:
