(b) The Board of Trustees:

(1) Has the care, control, and management of the college and all of its property and assets;

(2) May adopt any rules and regulations not inconsistent with law that it considers necessary for the government and management of the college; and

(3) ~~{May} IN CONSULTATION WITH THE HISTORIC ST. MARY'S CITY COMMISSION, MAY~~ appoint a President of the College who shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the College and the Chief of Staff for the Board.

(F) THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES MAY GRANT FULL FACULTY STATUS, WITH ALL THE RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES PERTAINING TO THAT STATUS, TO THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE HISTORIC ST. MARY'S CITY COMMISSION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That every person who, as of June 30, 1991, is employed by the Department of Housing and Community Development as a staff person of the St. Mary's City Commission in a position authorized by the State budget and not abolished by this Act is hereby transferred to the Historic St. Mary's City Commission, as provided in this Act, effective July 1, 1991, without any change or loss of rights, benefits, entitlements, or status, including, if any, merit system and retirement status, except as otherwise specifically provided in this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the St. Mary's City Commission is terminated by this Act and that the terms of members of the St. Mary's City Commission terminate on the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the terms of the initial members of the Historic St. Mary's City Commission who are appointed by the Governor shall expire as follows:

- (1) 4 members in 1995;
- (2) 4 members in 1994; and
- (3) 4 members in 1993.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, notwithstanding the provisions of § 5-207 of Article 83B as enacted by Section 1 of this Act, the Governor shall appoint the initial chairman of the Historic St. Mary's City Commission from among the initial appointees to the Commission. The initial chairman shall serve as chairman for a term of 3 years after which the provisions of § 5-207 providing for election of chairmen from among the members shall apply.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Historic St. Mary's City Commission and the Board of Trustees of St. Mary's College of Maryland shall develop jointly a plan for the identification, evaluation and preservation of significant
