- (B) (1) AN APPLICANT FOR A LICENSE SHALL SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE ADMINISTRATION ON THE FORM THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.
- (2) THE APPLICATION SHALL PROVIDE THE INFORMATION THAT THE ADMINISTRATION REQUIRES.
- (3) WHEN AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE IS FILED, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PROMPTLY INVESTIGATE THE APPLICANT.
- (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL ISSUE A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT WHO MEETS THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS PART AND THE REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER § 7-712 OF THIS PART.
- (D) (1) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL DENY A LICENSE TO ANY APPLICANT OR SUSPEND OR REVOKE A LICENSE IF THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE FAILS TO COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE LAWS AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE.
- (2) ANY APPLICANT OR LICENSEE WHO KNOWINGLY AND WILLFULLY MAKES A FALSE STATEMENT IN CONNECTION WITH AN APPLICATION UNDER THIS PART SHALL BE GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND UPON CONVICTION SHALL BE SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$1,000 OR IMPRISONMENT NOT EXCEEDING 1 YEAR OR BOTH.
- (3) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 4 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, BEFORE THE ADMINISTRATION TAKES ANY ACTION UNDER THIS SECTION, THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL GIVE THE APPLICANT OR LICENSEE NOTICE AND AN OPPORTUNITY FOR A HEARING.
- (E) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE RIGHT OF ANY PERSON TO PRACTICE A HEALTH OCCUPATION THAT THE INDIVIDUAL IS LICENSED OR OTHERWISE AUTHORIZED TO PRACTICE UNDER THE HEALTH OCCUPATIONS ARTICLE.

- (A) THE SECRETARY SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS FOR THE LICENSING OF PERSONS WHO PROVIDE COMMUNITY SUPPORTED LIVING ARRANGEMENTS SERVICES TO ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS THAT INCLUDE STANDARDS FOR:
 - (1) LICENSING PROVIDERS THAT INCLUDE:
- (I) MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND TRAINING REQUIREMENTS FOR PROVIDER STAFF:
 - (II) FINANCIAL OPERATING STANDARDS; AND
- (HH) GRIEVANCE PROCEDURES FOR RECIPIENTS OF COMMUNITY SUPPORTED LIVING ARRANGEMENTS SERVICES; AND
