13-108.

(A) Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle, when the Administration issues a certificate of title of a vehicle, it shall deliver the certificate of title by mailing it to the owner of the vehicle ~~UNLESS A TITLE SERVICE AGENT REQUESTS DELIVERY BY HAND AT A FACILITY OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE ADMINISTRATION.~~

(B) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, WHERE A VEHICLE HAS BEEN REPOSSESSED BY A LESSOR, LENDER OR CREDIT GRANTOR, THE LESSOR, LENDER OR CREDIT GRANTOR OR A TITLE SERVICE AGENT ON BEHALF OF THE LESSOR, LENDER OR CREDIT GRANTOR MAY REQUEST DELIVERY BY HAND AT A FACILITY OF THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE OF THE REPOSSESSED VEHICLE ON BEHALF OF THE LENDER OR CREDIT GRANTOR OR A DUPLICATE OF THE CERTIFICATE OF TITLE.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 617

(House Bill 1047)

AN ACT concerning

Campaign Finance Law - Revision

FOR the purpose of requiring each political committee to file the name of the committee and a statement of its purpose with a certain board; establishing certain requirements for the name and statement of purpose of a political committee; providing that certain loans and terms of loans shall be considered as contributions under certain circumstances; establishing a certain election cycle that includes the primary and general elections for the application of certain limits on contributions and transfers; altering the limits on contributions by persons in each election cycle; establishing ~~a limitation~~ certain limitations on the amount of money the treasurer of a political committee or the treasurer of a candidate may transfer to a candidate or political committee in each election cycle; providing certain exceptions to the limitations on contributions or transfers; establishing certain requirements for applying contribution limits to contributions made by a corporation; ~~requiring a contribution made from an account of or for the benefit of a minor child to be accompanied by the written consent of the child;~~ requiring the inclusion of certain information in certain literature or advertisements purchased by a person who makes certain independent expenditures; clarifying provisions of law requiring certain campaign materials and advertisements to contain authority lines; requiring
