SUBTITLE 6. WHOLESALE SALES REPRESENTATIVES.

3-601. DEFINITIONS.

(A) IN GENERAL.

IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED.

(B) COMMISSION.

"COMMISSION" MEANS COMPENSATION THAT:

(1) IS DUE TO A SALES REPRESENTATIVE FROM A PRINCIPAL;
AND

(2) ACCRUES AT:

(I) A SPECIFIED AMOUNT FOR EACH ORDER OR SALE; OR

(II) A RATE EXPRESSED AS A PERCENTAGE OF THE
DOLLAR AMOUNT THAT A SALES REPRESENTATIVE:

1. TAKES IN ORDERS FOR THE PRINCIPAL;
2. MAKES IN SALES FOR THE PRINCIPAL; OR
3. EARNS IN PROFITS FOR THE PRINCIPAL.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This subsection is new language derived without substantive change from former Art. 100, § 127(b).

In item (1) of this subsection, the former phrase "for payment" is deleted as unnecessary in light of the word "compensation".
