- (II) WITHOUT REGARD TO WHEN A CONTRIBUTION OR TRANSFER IS EXPENDED OR USED, THE CONTRIBUTION OR TRANSFER SHALL BE CHARGED AGAINST THE LIMITATION FOR THE ELECTION CYCLE IN WHICH:
 - 1. THE CHECK IS WRITTEN OR DATED; OR
- 2. THE CASH OR OTHER THING OF VALUE IS RECEIVED.
- (e) [(1) The following types of transfers are exempt from the \$1,000 and \$2,500 limitations set forth in subsection (d) of this section:
 - (i) From one candidate's treasurer to another candidate's treasurer;
- (ii) From the treasurer of a committee to the treasurer of another committee;
 - (iii) From a candidate's treasurer to the treasurer of a committee; and
 - (iv) From the treasurer of a committee to a candidate's treasurer.
- (2) Transfers to or from political clubs are subject to the limitations of subsection (b) of this section.]
- (1) IN THIS SUBSECTION, "POLITICAL COMMITTEE" INCLUDES A POLITICAL COMMITTEE REGISTERED UNDER § 26–4 OF THIS SUBTITLE, A FEDERAL POLITICAL COMMITTEE, AND AN OUT-OF-STATE POLITICAL COMMITTEE.
- (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, <u>DURING A 4-YEAR ELECTION CYCLE</u> THE TREASURER OF A POLITICAL COMMITTEE OR THE TREASURER OF A CANDIDATE MAY NOT DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY TRANSFER ANY MONEY GREATER THAN \$8,000 TO ANY CANDIDATE OR POLITICAL COMMITTEE IN ANY 4 YEAR ELECTION CYCLE.:
- (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, \$8,000 TO THE TREASURER OR POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO STATEWIDE OFFICE OR TO ANY OTHER POLITICAL COMMITTEE; AND
- (II) \$4,000 TO THE TREASURER OR POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTION TO AN OFFICE OTHER THAN A STATEWIDE OFFICE \$6,000 TO THE TREASURER OR POLITICAL COMMITTEE OF A CANDIDATE OR ANY OTHER POLITICAL COMMITTEE.
- (3) THE <u>LIMITATION</u> <u>LIMITATIONS</u> ON TRANSFERS <u>AND THE</u>
 <u>PROVISIONS ON AFFILIATIONS</u> SET FORTH IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
 SUBSECTION MAY NOT APPLY TO:
