AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the provisions of this Act relating to limits on contributions and transfers shall apply to the aggregate of all contributions and transfers made during the 4 year election cycle that began on January 1, 1991, however, for purposes of any election held before the effective date of this Act, the current limitations on contributions shall apply.~~

~~SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect January 1, 1992.~~

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except for any election subject to the provisions of Article 33 of the Code that is held during the 1991 calendar year, the provisions of this Act relating to limitations on contributions and transfers shall apply to the aggregate of all contributions and transfers made after the effective date of this Act. For purposes of any election held during the 1991 calendar year, the limitations on contributions and transfers under Article 33 of the Code that are in effect on June 30, 1991 shall apply.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, for the purposes of this Act, the period that begins on July 1, 1991 and continues through December 31, 1994 shall be deemed a 4-year election cycle.

SECTION 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

AN ACT concerning

Public Ethics Law - Revision

FOR the purpose of prohibiting lobbyists ~~or other registrants~~ registered under the Maryland Public Ethics Law, during a certain period, from soliciting, ~~arranging,~~ or transmitting certain political contributions, serving on certain committees, or acting as a treasurer ~~or chairman~~ for a candidate or political committee; providing certain exceptions; altering a definition; ~~requiring certain registrants to disclose all certain meals, beverages, or other gifts given during a reporting period to officials, employees, and members of the immediate families of officials and employees; requiring registrants to disclose certain information with regard to special events to which are invited certain members of the General Assembly; requiring the Commission to adopt certain guidelines;~~ and generally relating to the revision of certain provisions of the Maryland Public Ethics Law.
