- (a) Except as provided in § 4–301(b)(2), (6), [and] (7), AND 8 of this subtitle, the District Court does not have jurisdiction to try a criminal case charging the commission of a felony.
- (d) The jurisdiction of the District Court is concurrent with that of the circuit court in a criminal case:
- (1) In which the penalty may be confinement for three years or more or a fine of \$2,500 or more; or
- (2) Which is a felony, as provided in § 4–301(b)(2), (6), [and] (7), AND (8) of this subtitle.
