- (V) THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND EMPLOYMENT DEVELOPMENT; AND AND
- (VI) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE;
- (2) 1 CITIZEN MEMBER FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
 - (I) THE EASTERN SHORE; AND
 - (II) WESTERN MARYLAND: AND
 - (III) SOUTHERN MARYLAND; AND
- (3) 2 CITIZEN MEMBERS FROM EACH OF THE FOLLOWING AREAS:
 - (I) THE BALTIMORE METROPOLITAN AREA; AND
 - (II) THE WASHINGTON METROPOLITAN AREA.
- (C) ONE OF THE CITIZEN MEMBERS SELECTED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION SHALL HAVE AN EXPERTISE IN BICYCLE SAFETY.
- (C) (D) THE GOVERNOR SHALL SELECT A CHAIRMAN FROM AMONG THE CITIZEN MEMBERS.
- (D) (E) THE COMMITTEE SHALL MEET AT LEAST QUARTERLY WITH AT LEAST 1 MEETING HELD IN ANNAPOLIS.
- (E) (F) THE STAFF FOR THE COMMITTEE SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH AS DIRECTED BY THE GOVERNOR.
