- (II) PAY A QUARTERLY LICENSE FEE TO THE DEPARTMENT TO BE ESTABLISHED IN REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE SECRETARY AFTER CONSULTATION WITH OTHER STATE AGENCIES, INTERESTED PERSONS AND INDUSTRY REPRESENTATIVES THAT DOES NOT EXCEED \$1.75 PER TIRE; AND
- (III) CERTIFY TO THE DEPARTMENT, ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT, THE NUMBER OF TIRES TRANSFERRED BY THE LICENSEE TO RETAIL DEALERS DURING THE FEE QUARTER NO LATER THAN THE LAST DAY OF THE MONTH FOLLOWING THE FEE OUARTER.
- (3) THE RECORDS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE KEPT CONFIDENTIAL BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- (4) ALL-LICENSE FEES SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE USED TIRE CLEANUP AND RECYCLING FUND.
- (F) (G) (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (7) OF THIS SUBSECTION BEGINNING ON FEBRUARY 1, 1992, A TIRE RECYCLING FEE SHALL BE IMPOSED ON EACH RETAIL THE FIRST SALE OF A NEW TIRE IN THE STATE BY A TIRE DEALER, INCLUDING NEW TIRES SOLD AS PART OF A NEW OR USED VEHICLE, TRAILER, FARM IMPLEMENT, OR OTHER SIMILAR MACHINERY.
 - (2) THE TIRE RECYCLING FEE::
 - (I) MAY NOT EXCEED \$1.00 PER TIRE; AND
- (II) SHALL BE ESTABLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT AFTER CONSULTATION WITH:
 - 1. OTHER STATE AGENCIES;
 - 2. REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TIRE INDUSTRY; AND
 - 3. OTHER INTERESTED PERSONS BOARD OF PUBLIC

- (3) A RETAIL DEALER SHALL SEPARATELY STATE ON THE RETAIL SALES RECEIPT THE TIRE RECYCLING FEE CHARGED ON EACH RETAIL SALE OF A NEW TIRE.
- (3) FOR A SALE MADE BY A TIRE DEALER TO A PERSON WHO RESELLS TIRES, THE TIRE DEALER SHALL SEPARATELY STATE ITS RECYCLING FEES PAID BY THE TIRE DEALER ON THE INVOICE OR OTHER DOCUMENT OF SALE.
 - (4) EACH RETAIL TIRE DEALER SHALL:
 - (I) COLLECT PAY THE TIRE RECYCLING FEE; AND
