- (3) TRANSPORT EACH LOAD OF USED SCRAP TIRES TO THE USED SCRAP TIRE RECYCLERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- (H) (I) BEGINNING ON JULY 1, 1992, EACH USED SCRAP TIRE COLLECTION FACILITY SHALL:
- (1) REGISTER WITH THE DEPARTMENT ON A FORM THE DEPARTMENT PROVIDES;
- (1) IF LOCATED IN THE STATE, BE LICENSED BY THE DEPARTMENT TO RECEIVE TIRES FROM A CONSUMER OR A SCRAP TIRE HAULER;
- (2) APPLY FOR A LICENSE ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- (3) MEET ALL ZONING AND LAND USE REQUIREMENTS OF THE COUNTY OR MUNICIPAL CORPORATION IN WHICH THE TIRE COLLECTION FACILITY IS TO BE LOCATED;
- (2) (4) MANAGE USED SCRAP TIRES IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
- $\frac{(3)}{USED}$ $\frac{(5)}{SCRAP}$ TIRES TO:
 - (I) A USED SCRAP TIRE RECYCLER; OR
- (II) ANOTHER $\overline{\text{USED}}$ $\underline{\text{SCRAP}}$ TIRE COLLECTION FACILITY; AND
- (4) (6) IN ACCORDANCE WITH REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND ON FORMS PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT, PROVIDE:
 - (I) THE DEPARTMENT AND EACH HAULER WITH:
 - (1) 1. A RECORD OF THE DESTINATION;
- $\frac{\mbox{(II)}}{2.}$ The name of the Hauler that is registered with the department; and
- (HI) 3. THE QUANTITY OF EACH SHIPMENT OF USED SCRAP TIRES ON A FORM PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT; AND
 - (II) EACH HAULER WITH:
 - 1. A RECORD OF THE DESTINATION; AND
- 2. <u>THE QUANTITY OF EACH SHIPMENT OF SCRAP</u> TIRES.
