

2. IMPLEMENTATION OF ANY PROGRAM ESTABLISHED BY THE SERVICE AS A PART OF A SCRAP TIRE RECYCLING SYSTEM; AND

3. ASSISTING IN FUNDING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A PRIVATE OR PUBLIC SCRAP TIRE COLLECTION, PROCESSING, OR RECYCLING FACILITY.

(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE STANDING COMMITTEES OF THE MARYLAND GENERAL ASSEMBLY WITH PRIMARY JURISDICTION OVER THIS SECTION WITH A STATUS REPORT ON THE FUND ON OR BEFORE JULY 1 OF EACH YEAR. THE REPORT SHALL INCLUDE AN ACCOUNTING OF ALL MONEYS EXPENDED FOR EACH OF THE PURPOSES SPECIFIED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, by December 15, 1991, the Department of the Environment shall adopt final regulations necessary to implement the requirements of this Act. The Department shall develop the regulations in consultation with the Maryland Environmental Service and representatives of the tire industry and local government.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, prior to the enactment of the Fiscal Year 1993 operating budget, the Maryland Environmental Service may use money credited to the State Used Tire Cleanup and Recycling Fund under the provisions of this Act, with the approval of the Board of Public Works.

SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Department of Environment shall provide the General Assembly with an annual report, in accordance with § 2-1312 of the State Government Article, on the cumulative environmental impact of the incineration or burning of tires.

SECTION 2. 5. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

**(House Bill 1203)**

AN ACT concerning

**Creation of a State Debt - Town of North East - Police Administration Building**

FOR the purpose of authorizing the creation of a State Debt not to exceed ~~\$180,000~~ \$90,000 the proceeds to be used as a grant to the President and Commissioners of the Town of North East to be used for the completion of the construction of the Police Administration Building in the Town of North East, subject to the requirement that the President and Commissioners of the Town of North East provide a matching fund of a certain kind and amount for the same purpose by a
