- (4) The State's Attorney may appoint [additional] assistant State's Attorneys as approved by the County Commissioners and provided for in the Garrett County budget.
- (6) (i) Subject to the approval of the County Commissioners and if provided for in the Garrett County budget, the State's Attorney may appoint investigators.

(ii) [A] State's Attorney's [investigator:

- 1. Is at all times under the supervision and subject to the rules and regulations of the State's Attorney;
 - 2. Shall perform the duties designated by the State's Attorney;
- 3. Shall take an oath of office subscribed to before the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett County;
 - 4. Shall have at least:
- A. 10 years law enforcement experience in a federal, State, or county law enforcement agency; or
- B. 5 years law enforcement experience in a federal, State, or county law enforcement agency and an associate of arts or bachelor of arts degree in police science or criminology from an accredited institution of higher education;
- 5. Has the power to arrest persons committing offenses or crimes in Garrett County;
- 6. May exercise the general powers of a peace officer in Garrett County and may wear an appropriate metallic badge as prescribed by the State's Attorney; and
- 7. May possess and carry firearms or other weapons as required by the State's Attorney.
- (iii) Information obtained by a State's Attorney's investigator, as a result of any investigation, shall be kept confidential, and may not be divulged except under order by a court of record of this State, or for the proper administration of justice.
- (iv) The requirements of Article 41, Section 4–201 of the Code relating to the Police Training Commission apply to the position of State's Attorney's investigator in Garrett County] INVESTIGATORS SHALL BE LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS IN MARYLAND AND SHALL HAVE THE SAME POWERS, RIGHTS, PROTECTIONS, AND FRINGE BENEFITS AS DEPUTY SHERIFFS IN THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE OF GARRETT COUNTY.
- (7) THE STATE'S ATTORNEY MAY EMPLOY CLERICAL, ADMINISTRATIVE, INVESTIGATIVE, AND OTHER PERSONNEL AS MAY BE NECESSARY FOR THE PROPER CONDUCT OF THE OFFICE. THE SALARIES
