- (i) owned by the National Board of Young Men's Christian Associations; and
 - (ii) known as the Railroad YMCA of Cumberland;
 - (2) property that is owned by the Upper Potomac Jaycees, Incorporated;
 - (3) property that is owned by the Allegany Beagle Club, Incorporated; [and]
 - (4) property that is:
 - (i) leased by Frostburg Community Hospital, Inc.; and
 - (ii) used for hospital purposes; AND
- (3) (5) PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED BY THE WESTERN MARYLAND SCENIC RAILROAD.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 653

(House Bill 1328)

AN ACT concerning

Repeal of Sales and Use Tax Exemption for Cigarettes - Supplementary Appropriation for Medical Care Programs

FOR the purpose of repealing the exemption under the sales and use tax for the sale of cigarettes on which the tobacco tax is paid; providing for the legislative appropriation for a certain fiscal year of revenues derived from the repeal of a certain sales and use tax exemption; making this Act a supplementary appropriation to support certain costs for medical assistance; explaining the intent of the General Assembly; clarifying the method of computation of the sales and use tax; providing for the effective date of this Act; and generally relating to a certain exemption under the sales and use tax and a supplementary appropriation.
