Where any person is convicted after July 1, 1982, of any crime by any judge with criminal jurisdiction, there shall be imposed as additional cost, in the case, in addition to any other costs required to be imposed by law, the sum of \$15. ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED, AFTER JULY 1, 1991, OF VIOLATIONS OF § 21–902(A), (B), (C), OR (D) OF THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE SHALL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$15. All such sums shall be paid over to the Comptroller of the State to be deposited in the general funds of the State. Under no condition shall a political subdivision be held liable for the payment of this sum of \$15. "Crime" as used in this section does not include [violations of the Maryland Vehicle Law,] violations of the Agriculture or Natural Resources articles of this Code, or violations of State or local building, health, and sanitation codes.

- (2) "CONVICTED" INCLUDES A DISPOSITION UNDER ARTICLE 27, § 641 OF THE CODE.
- (3) "CRIME" DOES NOT INCLUDE A VIOLATION OF THE MARYLAND VEHICLE LAW, THE AGRICULTURE OR NATURAL RESOURCES ARTICLE OF THE CODE, OR A STATE OR LOCAL BUILDING, HEALTH, OR SANITATION CODE IF THE VIOLATION IS NOT PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the additional crimes covered by, and the expanded compensation eligibility under, the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act which are established by this Act shall apply only to crimes committed or occurring on or after October 1, 1991.

AN ACT concerning

North Point State Park and Black Marsh Wildland

FOR the purpose of establishing certain State land in Baltimore County as the North Point State Park; designating, holding, and managing the land under this Act as a State park; authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to adopt regulations concerning the North Point State Park; providing for the land designated under this Act to be subject to certain laws; providing that the provisions of this Act prevail
