

[(9)] (10) A regularly employed deputy sheriff of any county and who is compensated by the county and whose usual duties include the making of arrests;

[(10)] (11) A member of the Natural Resources police of the Department of Natural Resources;

[(11)] (12) A member of the Maryland Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Enforcement Unit; or

[(12)] (13) A member of the Maryland-National Capital Park and Planning Commission Park Police.

(b) "Law enforcement officer" means any person who, in his official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is a member of one of the following law enforcement agencies:

(1) The Maryland State Police;

(2) The Baltimore City police department;

(3) THE BALTIMORE CITY SCHOOL POLICE FORCE;

[(3)] (4) The police department, bureau, or force of any county;

[(4)] (5) The police department, bureau, or force of any incorporated city or town;

[(5)] (6) The office of the sheriff of any county;

[(6)] (7) The police department, bureau, or force of any bicounty agency or the University of Maryland;

[(7)] (8) The State Aviation Administration police force of the Department of Transportation, the Mass Transit Administration police force of the Department of Transportation, the Maryland toll facilities police force of the Maryland Transportation Authority, and the Maryland Port Administration police force of the Department of Transportation;

[(8)] (9) The police officers of the Department of Natural Resources; or

[(9)] (10) The Maryland Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Enforcement Unit.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act may not be construed to affect the validity or legality of the actions of the Baltimore City Police Force and Officers taken before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
