- (3) (I) ANY VENDING MACHINE INCOME THAT RESULTS FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION SHALL ACCRUE TO THE BLIND PERSON MANAGING THE VENDING FACILITY ON THE PROPERTY WHERE THE INCOME IS GENERATED IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE VENDING FACILITIES PROGRAM FOR THE BLIND.
- (II) IF THERE IS NO BLIND PERSON MANAGING THE VENDING FACILITY, THE VENDING MACHINE INCOME SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE DIVISION FOR THE SUPPORT OF THE PROGRAM.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 661

(House Bill 408)

AN ACT concerning

Mammography Testing , Certification of Medical Radiation Technologists, and Nuclear Medical Technologists – Requirements and Regulations

FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person after a certain date from performing mammography testing unless the center where the mammography testing is performed is certified; requiring the Secretary of the Environment in consultation with certain persons to adopt certain regulations; specifying that only certain persons may interpret the results of mammography testing; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene in consultation with certain persons to publish a certain list of centers; requiring the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene to update the list at least twice a year accredited under a certain program; defining certain terms; extending the date for the expiration of certain certificates of temporary certification issued to certain individuals; extending the date for the utilization of a certain test by the Board of Physician Quality Assurance; requiring the Board of Physician Quality Assurance in consultation with certain persons to adopt certain education and experience qualifications; requiring the Board of Physician Quality Assurance, in consultation with certain persons, to conduct a certain study and report to certain Committees by a certain date; and generally relating to the regulation of centers performing mammography testing.
