- 1. A. 6 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE STATEWIDE TEACHERS' ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING A MAJORITY OF TEACHERS IN THE STATE FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PURPOSES; AND
- 2. B. 2 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY A STATEWIDE TEACHERS' ORGANIZATION REPRESENTING TEACHERS IN AT LEAST ONE JURISDICTION WITHIN THE STATE FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING PURPOSES OTHER THAN THE MAJORITY ORGANIZATION PROVIDED FOR IN 1. (A) ABOVE ITEM 1 OF THIS SUBPARAGRAPH.

- (III) 6 SHALL BE TEACHER EDUCATION FACULTY MEMBERS FROM COLLEGES OF THE STATE, CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY:

- 2. THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGES OF TEACHER EDUCATION;
