- 3. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS:
- (V) 2 SHALL BE ADMINISTRATIVE OR SUPERVISORY STAFF OF THE APPROVED NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE, CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS:
- (VI) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION, CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF BOARDS OF EDUCATION:
- (VII) 2 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AS FOLLOWS:
- 1. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND; AND
- 2. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND; AND
- (VIII) 1 SHALL BE THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OR A DESIGNEE OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.
- (3) THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS AND TEACHER EDUCATION ADVISORY BOARD SERVING ON JULY 1, 1991.
- (B) (1) THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2)(I) THROUGH (VII) OF THIS SECTION.
- (2) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE BOARD IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:
  - (I) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND
- (II) MINORITY POPULATIONS OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN § 9–301 OF STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE OF THE MARYLAND CODE.
  - (C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.
- (2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON OCTOBER 1, 1991.
- (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
