

3. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS;

(V) 2 SHALL BE ADMINISTRATIVE OR SUPERVISORY STAFF OF THE APPROVED NONPUBLIC SCHOOLS OF THE STATE, CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF INDEPENDENT SCHOOLS;

(VI) 1 SHALL BE A MEMBER OF A LOCAL BOARD OF EDUCATION, CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE MARYLAND ASSOCIATION OF BOARDS OF EDUCATION;

(VII) 2 SHALL BE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE GENERAL PUBLIC, AS FOLLOWS:

1. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES OF MARYLAND; AND

2. 1 SHALL BE CHOSEN FROM A LIST OF NOMINEES PROVIDED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND; AND

(VIII) 1 SHALL BE THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT OR A DESIGNEE OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT.

(3) THE BOARD SHALL INCLUDE ALL THE MEMBERS OF THE PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS AND TEACHER EDUCATION ADVISORY BOARD SERVING ON JULY 1, 1991.

(B) (1) THE GOVERNOR, WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD DESCRIBED IN SUBSECTION (A)(2)(I) THROUGH (VII) OF THIS SECTION.

(2) IN MAKING THE APPOINTMENTS REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE GOVERNOR SHALL ENSURE THAT THE BOARD IS REPRESENTATIVE OF:

(I) THE GEOGRAPHIC REGIONS OF THE STATE; AND

(II) MINORITY POPULATIONS OF THE STATE AS DEFINED IN § 9-301 OF STATE FINANCE AND PROCUREMENT ARTICLE OF THE MARYLAND CODE.

(C) (1) THE TERM OF AN APPOINTED MEMBER IS 3 YEARS.

(2) THE TERMS OF THE APPOINTED MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE BOARD ON OCTOBER 1, 1991.

(3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED.
