- (4) A MEMBER WHO IS APPOINTED AFTER A TERM HAS BEGUN SERVES ONLY FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TERM AND UNTIL A SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
- (D) THE GOVERNOR MAY REMOVE A MEMBER FOR INCOMPETENCE OR MISCONDUCT.
- (E) FROM AMONG ITS MEMBERS, THE BOARD ANNUALLY SHALL ELECT A CHAIRMAN.
- (F) A MAJORITY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD THEN SERVING ON THE BOARD IS A QUORUM.
- (G) THE STAFF FOR THE BOARD SHALL BE PROVIDED BY THE STATE BOARD.

6-704.

- (A) (1) IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 1 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, AND WITH THE ADVICE OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, BOTH THE STATE BOARD AND THE BOARD SHALL ADOPT DEVELOP FOR CONSIDERATION RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR:
- (I) THE CERTIFICATION OF TEACHERS AND OTHER PROFESSIONAL PERSONNEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS ARTICLE; AND
- (II) REQUIREMENTS FOR PREPARATION OF TEACHERS AND OTHER EDUCATION PERSONNEL.
- (2) <u>RULES AND REGULATIONS DEVELOPED BY THE STATE BOARD</u> SHALL BE REVIEWED BY THE BOARD.
- (3) RULES AND REGULATIONS DEVELOPED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE REVIEWED BY THE STATE BOARD.
- (4) RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ARE INITIATED BY EITHER THE STATE BOARD OR THE BOARD AND SUBMITTED FOR REVIEW TO EACH OTHER SHALL BE ACTED UPON WITHIN 60 DAYS OF THEIR RECEIPT BY THE OTHER PARTY.
- (5) RECOMMENDATIONS ON RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ARE INITIATED BY THE BOARD SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED UNLESS DISAPPROVED BY THREE-FOURTHS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD.
- (6) RECOMMENDATIONS ON RULES AND REGULATIONS THAT ARE INITIATED BY THE STATE BOARD SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED UNLESS DISAPPROVED BY THE BOARD.
- (7) IF THE RULES OR REGULATIONS ARE DISAPPROVED UNDER PARAGRAPH (6) OF THIS SUBSECTION, THE RULES OR REGULATIONS SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED IF THEY ARE APPROVED BY THREE-FOURTHS OF THE MEMBERS OF THE STATE BOARD.
