- (1) 8 of the appointed members of the Board shall serve an initial term of 1 year;
- (2) 8 of the appointed members of the Board shall serve an initial term of 2 years; and
 - (3) 8 of the appointed members shall serve an initial term of 3 years.

SECTION 3. 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the incumbent members of the Professional Standards and Teacher Education Advisory Board who hold office on July 1, 1991 shall serve on the Professional Standards and Teacher Education Board, serve out their terms, and continue to hold office until their successors are appointed.

SECTION 4. <u>5.</u> AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.

CHAPTER 663

(House Bill 734)

AN ACT concerning

State Board of Certified Interior Designers

FOR the purpose of establishing a State Board of Certified Interior Designers; providing for the membership, officers, terms, powers, and duties of the Board; requiring an individual to be certified before the individual may use the title "certified interior designer" or the term "certified interior design services"; establishing certification requirements that include passing an examination; establishing waivers of certain requirements for certain individuals; providing for the issuance, scope, term, renewal, and reinstatement of certificates; authorizing the Board to deny a certificate to any applicant, reprimand any certificate holder, or suspend or revoke a certificate under certain circumstances; requiring the Board to offer certain individuals opportunities for a hearing; requiring a certified interior designer to state or disclose certain information; prohibiting certain acts and providing penalties for violations of certain provisions; defining certain terms; specifying the intent of the General Assembly that revenues of the Board be sufficient to meet the costs of the certification program; and generally relating to certified interior designers.
