SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

**Article 44A – Housing Authorities**

3-104.

(A) THERE IS A HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE FORCE.

(B) IN THIS SECTION, "HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE OFFICER" MEANS ANY PERSON WHO:

(1) IS A MEMBER OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE FORCE; AND

(2) WHEN ACTING IN AN OFFICIAL CAPACITY, IS AUTHORIZED BY LAW TO MAKE ARRESTS.

(C) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY OR THE DESIGNEE OF THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL APPOINT THE MEMBERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE FORCE.

~~(D)~~ (D) (1) A HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE OFFICER HAS ALL OF THE POWERS GRANTED TO A POLICE OFFICER OF THE BALTIMORE CITY POLICE DEPARTMENT OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE STATE.

(2) (1) A HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE OFFICER MAY EXERCISE THE POWERS GRANTED IN PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION ONLY ON, ~~OR IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF,~~ PROPERTY THAT IS OWNED, LEASED, OPERATED BY, OR UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY.

(II) A HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE OFFICER MAY NOT EXERCISE GRANTED POWERS ON ANY OTHER PROPERTY UNLESS:

1. ENGAGED IN FRESH PURSUIT OF A SUSPECTED OFFENDER;
