

- (iv) Section 111 (relating to destroying, injuring, etc., property of another);
- (v) Section 156 (relating to giving a false alarm of a fire);
- (vi) Section 287 (relating to possession of hypodermic syringes, etc., restricted);
- (vii) Sections 342 through 344 (theft) where the value of the property stolen was less than \$300;
- (viii) Section 33A (relating to breaking into building or boat with intent to steal);
- (ix) The common-law crime of assault when committed with intent to do great bodily harm;
- (x) Sections 276 through 302 (relating to drugs and other dangerous substances) as they shall be amended from time to time;
- (xi) Section 36B (relating to handguns);
- (xii) Section 388 (relating to manslaughter by automobile, motorboat, etc.); and
- (xiii) Section 335A (relating to indecent exposure).

(2) Attempts to commit the offenses specified in the following sections of Article 27 as they may be amended from time to time:

- (i) Section 8 (relating to burning personal property of another);
- (ii) Section 11 (relating to setting fire while perpetrating crime);
- (iii) Section 111 (relating to destroying, injuring, etc., property of another);
- (iv) Sections 342 through 344 (theft) where the value of the property stolen was less than \$300;
- (v) Section 33A (relating to breaking into a building or boat with intent to steal);
- (vi) Sections 276 through 302 (relating to drugs and other dangerous substances), as they shall be amended from time to time.

(g) For purposes of this section, the term "police officer" means any person who, in his official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is:

- (1) A member of the Maryland State Police;
- (2) A member of the Baltimore City police department;
- (3) A member of the police department, bureau, or force of any county;
