

(j) Nothing in this section shall impair any right of arrest otherwise existing under this Code.

(k) Nothing in this section deprives a person of the right to receive a citation for a traffic violation as provided in the Maryland Vehicle Law or for a criminal violation, as provided by law or rule of court.

(l) Nothing in this section shall alter the geographical area in which a police officer may act.

(m) Correctional employees assigned by the Commissioner of Correction to monitor inmates on home detention under § 689A of this article have the same powers of arrest for inmates in the home detention program as are set forth in this section for police officers.

(b) "Law enforcement officer" means any person who, in his official capacity, is authorized by law to make arrests and who is a member of one of the following law enforcement agencies:

- (1) The Maryland State Police;
- (2) The Baltimore City police department;
- (3) The police department, bureau, or force of any county;
- (4) The police department, bureau, or force of any incorporated city or town;
- (5) The office of the sheriff of any county;
- (6) The police department, bureau, or force of any bicounty agency or the University of Maryland;
- (7) The State Aviation Administration police force of the Department of Transportation, the Mass Transit Administration police force of the Department of Transportation, the Maryland toll facilities police force of the Maryland Transportation Authority, and the Maryland Port Administration police force of the Department of Transportation;
- (8) The police officers of the Department of Natural Resources; [or]
- (9) The Maryland Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Enforcement Unit; OR
- (10) HOUSING AUTHORITY OF BALTIMORE CITY POLICE FORCE.
