4-205.

- (a) In addition to the powers set forth elsewhere in this title, the Board may:
 - (1) Adopt regulations governing:
 - (i) The administration of general anesthesia by a licensed dentist;
 - (ii) The administration of parenteral sedation by a licensed dentist;
- (iii) The use of a dental assistant by a licensed dentist in performing intraoral procedures;
- (iv) The issuance of a permit to a facility not otherwise regulated where a dentist administers or has general anesthesia or parenteral sedation administered;
- (v) The issuance of a permit to a dentist who administers or has general anesthesia or parenteral sedation administered;
