## AN ACT concerning

## Municipal Corporation Property Tax - Homeowners Tax Credit Local Supplement

FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of a municipal corporation to grant, by law, a local supplement to a certain homeowners tax credit; authorizing the governing body of a municipal corporation to alter certain provisions and to provide additional limitations on eligibility for purposes of a local supplement to the homeowners tax credit; providing for the applicability of this Act; and generally relating to authorization for the governing body of a municipal corporation to grant a local supplement to a certain homeowners tax credit.
