- (C) "STATE UNIT" MEANS A UNIT OF THE EXECUTIVE OR LEGISLATIVE BRANCH OF STATE GOVERNMENT.

- (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, AN OFFICIAL OR EMPLOYEE OF A STATE UNIT MAY NOT DUPLICATE 10 OR MORE INDIVIDUAL PAGES OF ANY PRINTED MATERIALS BY PHOTOCOPYING OR PRINTING, UNLESS THE COPIES USE BOTH SIDES OF EACH SHEET OF PAPER.
- (B) (1) THE SECRETARY OF A STATE UNIT, OR AS APPROPRIATE, THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FISCAL SERVICES, OR THE DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LEGISLATIVE REFERENCE MAY AUTHORIZE THE DUPLICATION OF MATERIALS THAT ARE COPIED ON ONLY 1 SIDE OF EACH SHEET BY PROVIDING WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION BEFORE EACH SPECIFIC DUPLICATION THAT CITES SPECIFIC REASONS FOR SINGLE-SIDED DUPLICATION.
- (2) THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO THE LAST SHEET USED IN THE DUPLICATION OF AN ODD NUMBER OF PAGES.
- (C) EACH STATE UNIT SHALL PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO ITS EMPLOYEES OF THE REQUIREMENTS FOR DOUBLE-SIDED DUPLICATION UNDER THIS SECTION.
