

~~(4) IN THE EVENT AN INSPECTION AT A DENTAL OFFICE OR FACILITY DISCLOSES A CONDITION WHICH REQUIRES A REINSPECTION OF A DENTAL RADIATION MACHINE, A REINSPECTION FEE NOT TO EXCEED \$25 PER MACHINE MAY BE ESTABLISHED.~~

~~SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That all fees assessed on dental radiation machines and received by the Department from April 1, 1990 to July 1, 1991, shall be credited towards the fees to be assessed under § 8-301(c)(1) and (4) of the Environment Article as enacted by this Act.~~

(I) FOR THE FIRST 3 YEARS BEGINNING JULY 1, 1991, \$30 PER DENTAL RADIATION MACHINE PER YEAR; AND

(II) AFTER JUNE 30, 1994, \$40 PER DENTAL RADIATION MACHINE PER YEAR.

(3) IF A DENTAL RADIATION MACHINE IS NOT INSPECTED WITHIN ANY 3-YEAR PERIOD AND ALL ANNUAL FEES WERE PAID DURING THAT 3-YEAR PERIOD, AN ADDITIONAL ANNUAL INSPECTION FEE IS NOT REQUIRED TO BE PAID UNTIL A DENTAL RADIATION MACHINE INSPECTION IS PERFORMED BY A STATE INSPECTOR.

(4) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, INSPECTION OF THE DENTAL RADIATION MACHINES AT EACH DENTAL OFFICE OR FACILITY MAY NOT BE PERFORMED MORE THAN ONCE EVERY 3 YEARS.

(II) INSPECTION OF THE DENTAL RADIATION MACHINES AT A DENTAL OFFICE OR FACILITY MAY BE PERFORMED MORE THAN ONCE EVERY 3 YEARS IF THE DEPARTMENT HAS GROUNDS TO BELIEVE THAT:

1. A VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE OR ANY RULE, REGULATION, ORDER, REGISTRATION, CERTIFICATE, OR LICENSE ADOPTED OR ISSUED UNDER THIS TITLE MAY EXIST; OR

2. A HAZARD ASSOCIATED WITH THE USE OF RADIATION MAY EXIST.

(D) THE PROVISIONS OF SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C) OF THIS SECTION RELATING TO FEES FOR MONITORING AND REGULATING SOURCES OF RADIATION DO NOT APPLY TO A DENTAL SCHOOL ACCREDITED BY THE COMMISSION ON DENTAL ACCREDITATION OF THE AMERICAN DENTAL ASSOCIATION.

~~SECTION 3-2.~~ AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1991.
